Oil and HNS Pollution, Preparedness, Response and Co-operation Courses

Marine Environment Protection

The aim of training is to create a realistic mechanism in oil spill response which will provide your facility with the required knowledge of responding effectively in emergency incidents and taking all the appropriate preventive measures. The seminar includes demonstration of equipment and antipollution exercises in order to confirm the operational preparedness.

The courses can be delivered in EPE's modern Training Center in the Industrial Park of Schisto or in the facilities of your choice. Additionally, our company offers you the possibility of delivering the courses in two languages (Greek and English). All EPE's activities including our training services are certified according to ISO 9001:2008.



COURSES

IMO Level 1 – First Responders

This course provides the personnel who will first respond to an accident (technicians, crew) with the required knowledge for the immediate mobilization and efficient implementation of operations during the first crucial hours of a spill, through detailed presentations of response methods and practical application of them.

Course Duration: Three Days

Validity: Three Years

IMO Level 2 – On Scene Commanders

The course is designed for coordinators who will lead or supervise oil spill response teams with a view to the safe and efficient management of all antipollution means and involved personnel, the constant evaluation of the operations' progress as well as the environmental, socio-economic assessment. The seminar includes demonstration of equipment and table-top exercises.

Course Duration: Four Days

Validity: Three Years

IMO Level 3 – Spill Management

Spill Management Course is designed for all senior officials, administrators and senior managers of shoreline facilities mainly focused on planning, preparedness and spill response as well as strategic decision making in vital issues such as political implications, compensation and media. The seminar includes also theoretical exercises and Case Studies.

Course Duration: Three Days

Validity: Three Years

Oil Spill Awareness Course

This awareness course is designed for all operational staff of ports, shoreline facilities and local authorities and gives the participants the foundational understanding and practical skills that are essential for the successful implementation of response methods taking into account health and safety issues.

Course Duration: One Day

HNS Spill Awareness Course

The introductory course is designed for all operational staff of ports, shoreline facilities and local authorities and is focused on the main issues of an HNS spill response operation.

Course Duration: One Day

Introduction to Marine HNS Response at Operational Level

This course is designed for personnel who will be involved in the coordination and effective management of all the required antipollution means and involved staff.

Course Duration: Three Days

Introduction to Marine Spill Response for Shipping Industry

This seminar is designed for all seamen (captains, engineers, abs) as well as personnel of the Operations Dpt, SQM Dpt and DPA within a shipping company who will be involved in the pollution response of an incident caused by their vessel.

Course Duration: Two Days
